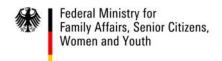

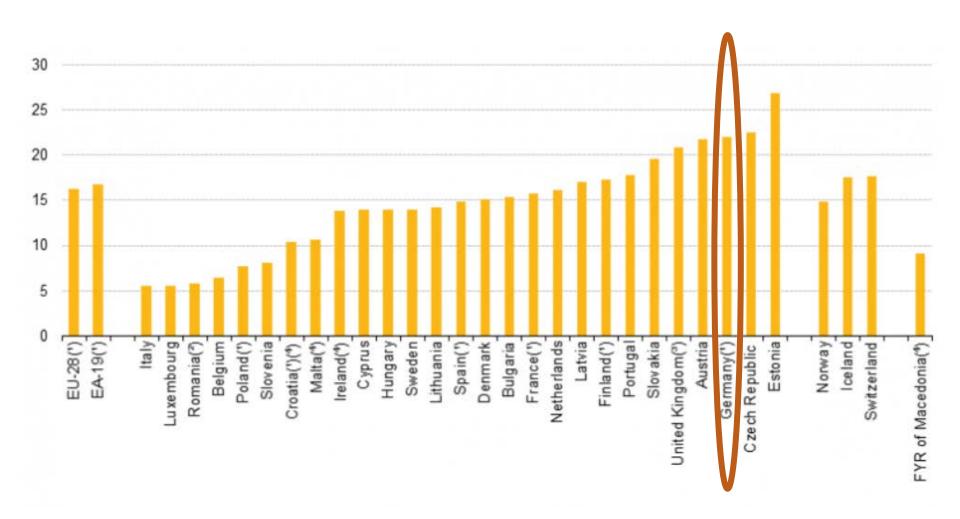

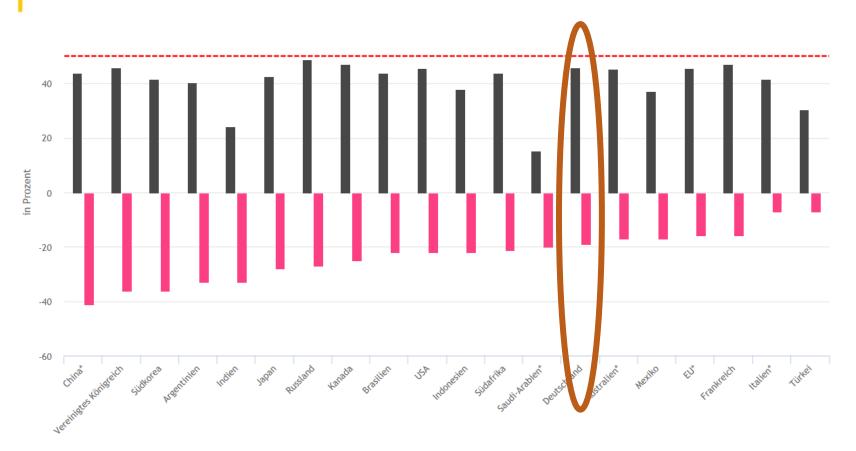


Gender Pay Gap in 2015 - EU -



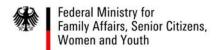

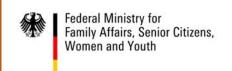
Individual disclosure right to request pay information
